



The Duggan Cruising Cup: A pursuit race
Saturday July 16, 2016

Rules

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016**, wherein the sailing instructions are the RStLYC 2016 Standing Sailing Instructions (SSI) and any addenda thereto with respect to this event posted on the Official Notice Board.

Entries

Entries must meet eligibility of a Club-Racing Event. The Duggan Cruising Cup is restricted to single-hull keelboats of the Cruising Class. Cruising Class yachts are defined as a yacht with a head and sleeping accommodations. All boats must have a valid SLVYRA time on distance handicap or interim handicap to be used for computing provisional race results. This is a White Sail event where yachts and their crews are required to spend the night before the race at anchor away from the Club (anchoring in Dowker's Bay following the prior evening's Friday Fun race would be convenient!). Yachts must register with the Committee Boat on Channel 77 around 09:30 hours.

Schedule

One race is scheduled on Saturday, July 16 2016. The first signal will be at 1030 hours.

Course, Starting order & Starting Times

The course, starting order and times will be announced by the Committee Boat on Channel 77 at approximately 10:00 hours.

Prizes will be awarded at the RStLYC Annual Prize Giving Ceremony in November
