1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in [The Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS).
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) is the RStLYC.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text takes precedence.
- 1.4 This is either a **white sail or with spinnaker** race. The choice must be given during registration at the skipper’s meeting.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions (SI) will be available on June 1, 2023.

3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 The online Official Notice Board is located at <http://www.sail123.com/onbr.htm>
Race documents and results may also be posted on the board located immediately outside the RStLYC office.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all cruising class keelboats of the Royal St Lawrence Yacht Club with a valid SLVYRA PHRF handicap. Cruising class keelboat yachts are defined as yachts with a head and sleeping accommodations.
- 4.2 Registration for the event will be taken at the skipper’s meeting held on the club front lawn of RStLYC prior to racing.
- 4.3 The race is a pursuit format. The starting time of individual yachts will be calculated with the Time on Distance (T/D) SLVYRA PHRF handicap ratings. These times will be provided at the skipper’s meeting.

5 SERIES

- 5.1 The event will consist of one long distance race of approximately 20 nautical miles. If water levels permits, the course will possibly reach a mark in front of Beauharnois Seaway Locks.
- 5.2 The Lord Strathcona Cup is also the first race of the Long Distance Series. The Windmill Point Challenge Shield is the second race and the Hugh Kennedy Award is the third and last race of the Long Distance Series.
