1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) is the RStLYC.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text takes precedence.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions (SI) will be available at least one week before the start of the series.

3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

3.1 The online Official Notice Board is located at <u>RStLYC Official Notice Board</u> Race documents and results may also be posted on the board located immediately outside the RStLYC office.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The RStLYC Archie Cameron Trophy is open to Lighting class sailboats belonging to members in good standing of a SLVYRA club.
- 4.2 Classes are defined as follows:

Division 1 Lightning

4.3 Eligible boats may enter by sailing past the transom of the Race Committee vessel and hailing their sail number, skipper name, and class.

5 SERIES

5.1 The event will consist of a maximum of 5 races.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

6.1 The Royal St Lawrence Yacht Club Archie Cameron Trophy has the following number of races scheduled:

Class	Races per day schedule	Races per day maximum
Division 1	5 races	5 races

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the RStLYC Archie Cameron Trophy first race is 10:30 AM or when all expected boats are in the starting area, whichever is earlier.
