# **10 COURSES**

- 10.1 The diagram below in *Archie Cameron Trophy SI Addendum A Course Layouts* shows the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 10.2 The RC may notify sailors on the water prior to the next race a change of the course to Start 1 *Finish* in the event of lower wind or to enable sailing an additional race before the cutoff.



### 11 MARKS

11.1 The marks that may be used are as follows: yellow inflatable cylinders, orange tetrahedrons and orange balls.

- 12.2 Races will be started using RRS 26 with the warning signal made 3 minutes before the starting signal. This changes the <u>SSI</u>.
- 12.3 A boat that does not start within 4 minutes after its starting signal will be scored *Did Not Start (DNS)* without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
